Dear candidate,

Thank you for expressing an interest to attend the Custody Healthcare Practitioner Recruitment Event, we look forward to meeting you.

We recommend that you bring a copy of your up to date CV to the event. All attendees must bring with them photographic ID.

During the event you will have a chance to meet with our team and discuss the opportunities we have available.

We also offer the opportunity to have an initial interview with our interview panel (this is optional) if you meet the essential criteria for the role, as outlined in the job advert and on our [website](#):

Essential criteria

- You must be a first level registered adult nurse, mental health nurse or paramedic holding current registration with the Nursing and Midwifery Council/Health and Care Professions Council.
- You must have been registered for a minimum of three years.
- You will have a competency level equivalent to NHS Band 6 within the health service.
- You MUST be competent in venepuncture on your first day of appointment

Expressing an interest to attend initial interview at the event (optional)

If you are interested in attending initial interview please email us in advance to register so we can ensure we see you on the day. You can do this by emailing recruitment.marketing@police.sscl.com and letting our team know you would like to attend the initial interview. You will need to specify the name and the date of the event you will be attending in the email, and provide your contact details. You will also need to bring your up to date CV with you on the day.

If you need any reasonable adjustments to attend the initial interview at the event please let us know when emailing us, ideally at least 7 days before the event.

When you attend the event you will simply need to let us know that you have registered for the interview and we will review your CV and complete the initial sift before interviewing you.

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Additional information for candidates who express an interest in attending the interview during the event

After the initial interview at the event, panel will provide you with the interview outcome.

Unsuccessful candidates will be informed of the outcome on the day and will receive feedback.

Successful candidates will be invited to the next stage of the process, which will depend on whether they have already submitted their application or not, as outlined below.

a) **Candidates who have submitted their applications for the role prior to the event**

If you have submitted your application prior to attending the event and you passed the sift and initial interview (which you attended at the event), you will be invited to attend face to face interview with our panel members.

b) **Candidates who haven't submitted their applications for the role prior to the event**

If you have passed your initial interview during the event, you will be invited to submit the application online. Please note that we won't be able to complete all eligibility checks at the event, this will be done at the point when you submit your application.

Once you have applied online, we will complete the initial sift to ensure all eligibility criteria are met, and if successful, we will invite you directly for the face to face interview.
